Attendance Policy

Active Brothers should attend 80% of all regularly scheduled chapter meetings, committee meetings of which they are a part, and special meetings as well as attend all rituals. Failure to attend 80% of meetings in one semester without a valid excuse and/or failure to attend a ritual without a valid excuse will result in a change of status from Active to Associate. Brothers may appeal a status change to the Chapter Review Board. Brothers who cannot attend a meeting should submit a letter of excuse twenty-four (24) hours prior to the meeting to only the Sergeant-at-Arms. Any decision of the Sergeant-at-Arms may be appealed to the Vice President of Membership.

The following are not considered valid excuses: homework, tests without extenuating circumstances, convocations without extenuating circumstances or prior approval from the Sergeant-at-Arms, or respective committee chairperson, going home, minor illness at the discretion of the Sergeant-at-Arms, family emergencies without notice within 24 hours post-event, and other reasons at the discretion of the and/or Sergeant-at-Arms.

In the case of a private matter, a brother should discuss with the Vice-President of Membership their reason for being absent. The brother can be excused at the discretion of the Vice-President of Membership, who will immediately notify the Sergeant-at-Arms of his/her decision
