LETTER FROM THE DIRECTOR: CENTRETERM AND SPRING INTERNSHIPS

Don't forget--the deadlines for students to turn in internship contracts for both CentreTerm and spring term are fast approaching!

Internships are another great way for students to test-drive a career, gain experience to put on their resume, or make their graduate school applications stronger.

Juniors and seniors are eligible to participate in credit-bearing internships. They can receive three units of academic credit, which count toward their semester's courseload, but do not count for or against their major, minor or GPA. Academic internships require a substantial academic component and a faculty mentor--students must complete readings, journal

assignments, papers, and/or other assignments as agreed upon in their contracts. They must work 12 hours during all 13 weeks of classes or 35-40 hours a week for four weeks during the CentreTerm. The experience ends with a presentation to other interns and faculty mentors.

ADDITIONAL INTERNSHIP INFORMATION

Centre Internship Plus for CentreTerm

Centre College provides matching grants for selected internships during the CentreTerm and summer through a program called Centre Internship Plus (CIP). These internships can either be academic-credit or non-credit internships during the summer and academic-credit only internships during CentreTerm. Selected students receive up to \$750 minus taxes for CentreTerm and up to \$1500 minus taxes for the summer.

This is an extremely competitive process in which the student submits a proposal, the CIP Committee reviews the proposals, and the grants are awarded to high-quality internships. Because of the competitive nature of CIP, it is highly recommended that students ask their career counselors to review their proposals before submitting them.

If your student will be participating in an extraordinary internship during the CentreTerm, encourage him or her to apply today! The deadline for CentreTerm proposals is November 20th.

Summer Internships: Is It Too Early to Start the Search?

Is it too early for students to begin the search for a summer internship? The answer is a resounding "No!" Most deadlines (especially for big-name organizations) occur during early or mid spring. This means that students should start researching and possibly applying for positions during the fall term and Christmas break.

If students are not sure where to start looking for a summer internship, we highly recommend that they make an appointment with their career counselors to discuss their options. We have many resources available to students, including eRecruiting and several other national and international databases found on our Summer Jobs and Internships page on our website. And finally, we encourage students to talk to you, their professors, and other family members and friends to see if they have any networking leads.

And don't forget that they can apply for Centre Internship Plus funding for extraordinary summer internships.
