### Applied Music Lessons

WITHDRAWALS AFTER THE OFFICIAL DROP DATE RECEIVE NO REFUND (AFTER THE SECOND WEEK OF CLASSES).*

**NOTE: Students registering for applied music courses have the option to take the course for two credit hours (one-hour lessons per week instead of one-half-hour per week). Instructor's permission is required for 100 and 200-level students to take lessons for two credit hours. Students who wish to take an applied music course for two credit hours must contact the Registrar's Office by the drop/add deadline to have the credit hours changed from one to two.**
